

## **Parking for the surgeries**

### **STANMORE**

**Stanmore surgery** is within a 'controlled zone' where parking restrictions apply from 8.00 am to 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday.

There are several parking bays adjacent to the surgery and the on-street pay and display meter is immediately outside. The first 20 minutes are **free** then it costs 30p per 20 minutes. You **must** take a ticket when you first park, even if it is only for the free period. You enter your registration number for the ticket to be issued..

Within a few minutes' walk, there are parking bays for 'Resident Permits only'. Outside the hours shown on the signs for these bays, which are 10.00 to 11.00 am and 3.00 to 4.00 pm, you may park free in them.

### **BURNT OAK**

Other than the usual yellow line limitations, parking is without restriction in the roads around the Burnt Oak surgery. However, you may need to allow extra time before your appointment as free spaces can sometimes be hard to find! Please be considerate not to cause obstruction to local residents.

### **General**

**WMC** has consulted in the past with Barnet and Harrow councils but without success in obtaining any concessions. Note that both surgery premises have limited parking space which is reserved for the doctors, nurses and other staff. Please do not attempt to use these spaces or obstruct them.

**Blue badge** holders may park on single or double yellow lines for up to three hours except where there is a ban on loading or unloading.

**Dropped curbs:** It is a contravention of the Traffic Management Act 2004 to park a vehicle in front of a lowered footway. This applies to all lowered footways, including access drives, pedestrian crossing points and pram crossings. The single exception is that vehicles may park in front of lowered footways giving access to single properties with the permission of the owner of the property.
